

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is our Montessori-inspired parish faith formation for children K – Grade 6. The pandemic moved our trained catechists to record short 10 minute Presentations based on Gospel parables and other teachings of Jesus which then are broadcast monthly on the 1st and 3rd Sundays.

Beginning on the 3rd Sunday of this month – November 15 – an optional in-person experience will be offered for children registered in CGS Level I (K-1st Grades) and Level II (2nd – 3rd Grades). Following strict safety guidelines, we are glad to be able to make available safely and smartly the chance for a limited number of children to be in the atria with their catechist.

Additionally, we will begin archiving all Presentations on the parish webpage for ease of access for families to view as often as you like knowing their personal and positive impact at home.

Purpose 2.0 is our LifeTeen-inspired parish faith formation for middle school children culminating in the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation near the end of the 8th Grade year. The pandemic led to a special partnership with Catholic Youth Summer Camp located near Columbus. This outstanding organization who understands and relates well with the younger culture is producing weekly videos we are making available to registered families. As an assistance to our families, we view and recommend a shorter segment to watch together as a family with conversation starters.

Beginning on the Second Sunday of this month – November 8 – we will offer an optional in-person experience for all registered 7th & 8th Graders immediately after 5:30 p.m. Mass from 6:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. A light snack will be provided.
