Catechesis of the Good Shepherd at Little Flower

THIS WEEK IN THE ATRIUM

The Empty Tomb Mark 16:1-8

We used materials and scripture to recall the discovery of the empty tomb after Jesus death. We considered the events on the way to the tomb and the discovery of the empty tomb by a group of women. We contemplated the words of the man at the tomb as the proclamation of the Good News. Your child may have worked with the materials, used a tracing card or created art to further reflect on this passage, or read and copied the scripture passage on their own.

Each student had the opportunity to work with the materials of their choice and spent time in group prayer and reflection.

Consider with your Child:

-Each of the gospel writers included different details in their account. Reread this gospel account (or one of the other ones: Matthew 28:1-8 or John 20:3-9). Closing your eyes, use your imagination to place yourself in the scene of the empty tomb. How would you feel upon discovering the empty tomb? How would you feel about hearing the news that you will find the risen Jesus in the next city? Carry these emotions with you to Easter Sunday.



This Week:

-Using the attached stations of the cross handouts, take 1-2 stations of the cross each day (during morning or bedtime prayers perhaps?) and have your child write, color or draw a prayer response to each station.
