



WHO SHOULD COME?

Our bishop has extended the dispensation from Sunday Mass indefinitely. It is not a sin to remain away for responsible reasons and our livestream will continue for every Mass.

- Anyone with a cough or fever, or who is feeling sick, should not come to church for Mass or even for a visit.
- Those more advanced in years and anyone who has an underlying health condition that increases vulnerability, please stay home and continue to *livestream Mass*.

WHERE DO I GO?

Beginning April 10, 2021 if attending Mass in person, you may use any of our four entrances. If preferring to remain in your car or stay outside and livestream Mass, park in the lot closest to Dorr Street (on the south side of the building)

- **FACE COVERINGS ARE MANDATORY INSIDE THE BUILDING.**
- Once church capacity is reached, the narthex, St. Francis Room and O'Grady Community Center will be used for additional seating.
- For those preferring to remain in your vehicle or choose to livestream Mass outside, Holy Communion will be distributed at the tower/office entrance.

WHAT ELSE WILL LOOK DIFFERENT?

Your safety is our supreme concern. Because of our commitment to thorough church sanitation, including air purifiers which include hallways and bathrooms, there are new routines for us to all learn and practice.

- Everyone is asked to sanitize hands upon entrance to the building. You may also use your personal sanitizer prior to receiving Holy Communion.
- Respect the CDC's distancing standard of 3 ft in the pews if not with your immediate family.
- Face coverings are required.
- Hymnals will not be used.
- The Sign of Peace and the holding of hands during the Our Father has been suspended.
- There will be no distribution of the Precious Blood
- The bishop strongly encourages reception of Holy Communion in the hand, and the Eucharist cannot be received while wearing gloves.
- After receiving the Sacred Host, take a step or two to one side, remove your mask, receive the Blessed Sacrament, replace your mask and return to your seat. Let us know if we can bring the Sacred Host to your seat.
- The drinking fountain will not be available for use.
