### Join Us Via Livestream, Do Not Come To Church, If You:

- Are sick or showing any symptoms of illness, however mild, do not come to church.
- Have been in close contact and/or exposed to someone sick with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- Have been in a high-risk area and have not been tested.

### Precautionary Measures:

We all can help limit the spread of any virus. It is very important that everyone:

- Frequently wash hands with soap and water.
- Use sanitizer when entering and exiting our church and any parish building.
- Cover mouth and nose with flexed elbow or tissue when coughing and sneezing, and immediately throw tissue away and wash or sanitize hands.
- If you have a cough, even from allergies, consider wearing a mask as a courtesy to your fellow parishioners. We have them conveniently available in the Narthex.

For most people COVID-19 causes only mild illness, but it can make some people very ill. In rare cases, the virus can be fatal. Older people and those with preexisting medical conditions (such as high blood pressure, heart problems or diabetes) appear to be more vulnerable.
